Instruction for use

TABLE with plywood legs

EN 15372:2023, level 3

Tabletop 26mm. Made from 25mm chipboard, which is covered with laminate on top and brown backing laminate under table-top. Edges 4mm thick birch solid wood. Wooden edges are glued to the chipboard and pressed between top and backing laminate, which makes fixing of edges extra strong. Edges and corners of board are rounded 2mm. Table legs are made of 60x30 mm bent birch plywood, or 80x30 mm for larger tables, finished with a light-tinted lacquer.

Assembly

No assembly required – ready to use.

Intended Use

Designed for use in public indoor spaces for short or several-hour periods under light to heavy load conditions.

Examples of end-use: hotels, libraries, offices (excluding desks and workstations), cafés, restaurants, public halls, meeting rooms, canteens, lounges, and public areas in hospitals.

Safety and Maintenance

- Place the table on a flat surface.
- Do not stand or sit on the table.
- Do not drag the table across the floor.
- The table is intended for indoor use only.
- Protect the table from excessive moisture, direct sunlight and heat.

Cleaning

- For daily cleaning of the laminate, use water and a mild detergent. Use a household cloth or a piece of cotton fabric. After cleaning, dry the surface with a dry cloth or paper towel.
- Stains and dirt should be removed immediately to prevent drying and absorption into the material.
- Do not use abrasive materials (including scouring pads) or acidic cleaners.
